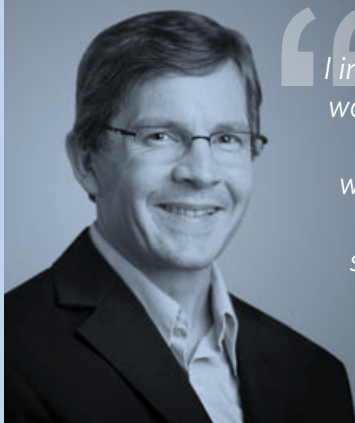
## Fly-in Physicians Needed
